3. Supply of Four Wheel Drive vehicle and recovery gear
4. Provide two forms of identity for enrolment paperwork (Drivers licence, Medicare, Passport, Birth Cert etc.)
5. Wear appropriate clothing and footwear
6. Be proficient in English
 - Identify any areas where participants may need additional support
 - Minimum written and /or oral English level
